DISPLAY RULES

1. We welcome all motorcycle racing disciplines and motorcycle groups to attend our event to display and spread the word of motorcycling to the community.
2. While this event is all about motorcycles we welcome anyone to participate in the display portion. If you have something that you believe would be connected to the motorcycling community or beneficial to our event please contact us to discuss.
3. The main gate will **open** at 7am and **close** at 915am sharp in order to secure the area for safe set up for all participants.
4. If a group - All vehicles in your group must arrive together. No exceptions please.
5. Display sites measure 20' x 20' Think about your display in advance and book enough spots to accommodate. Ensure you have enough space to fit everything you plan on keeping on your space. Keep in mind trailers, trailer doors, ramps, tables, displays, chairs, tents etc. Please try and keep it connected to the event. If it doesn't fit on your space, you'll need more space. Please book in advance.
6. Display sites are free of charge for groups and organizations associated to motorcycling. However we ask that you do not engage in the sale of anything other than swag or promotional items for your group. This is a courtesy to dealers and others who have paid to display and those that have paid for Swap sites. Swap sites are \$30 each, cash please.
7. Please register for your spot(s) on or before May 8th.
8. We are very hopeful that this event draws out attendees of all ages etc., please be respectful of all.
9. Pets are allowed but must be leashed and controlled at all times. Please clean up after your pet(s).
10. As we have food vendors that have committed to the event please respect no outside food.
11. Failure to comply with these rules may affect your eligibility to participate in the future.
12. Violators may be removed from the property.
13. We are hopeful that this event takes off and we can make it an annual event. Your participation will help. If you have any suggestions, comments, concerns please let a MSTO-NWO team member know.
